Day by Day Itinerary

Mon., Oct. 5 – FOX VALLEY / TRAVERSE CITY
Early this morning we depart the Fox Valley as a day of travel will take us across the Indiana and Michigan state lines before stopping in **Holland**, Michigan. Nestled into the wildly beautiful Lake Michigan shoreline, this multifaceted town is known for many things ~ springtime tulips, summer festivals, fall orchards, and winter holidays. We'll enjoy lunch at the **Boatwerks Waterfront Restaurant**, downtown Holland's favorite waterfront restaurant, and set aside time to stroll Eighth Street, the center of Holland's commercial shopping district since the founding of the city in 1847.

This afternoon we will set our sights on Traverse City, recognized by The Wall Street Journal as one of the 10 Best Places to Go in 2025 and named one of Midwest Living's 30 Great Midwest Fall Color Getaways. Our home for the next 4-evenings is the Hotel Indigo Traverse City, located downtown on beautiful West Grand Traverse Bay. As we'll soon find out, downtown Traverse City is a hub of entertainment for the region, and there is a little something for everyone. **(L,D)**

Tues., Oct. 6 – TRAVERSE CITY (Leelanau)

Our day will begin with an introduction to and exploration of the Leelanau Peninsula. We'll stop in small village of Empire, home to the Headquarters for Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore, to visit the **Philip A. Hart Visitor Center** for an introduction to the lakeshore as we explore the interpretive displays and watch a short informative movie. Then, we'll make our way to the **Pierce Stocking Scenic Drive** for panoramic views of the Manitou Passage and the



distant lighthouses of North and South Manitou Islands. This 7.4-mile scenic drive provides visitors with insight into the history of the area, a sampling of the vegetative communities found within the park and, best of all, spectacular overlooks of the Glen Lakes, the Sleeping Bear Dunes and Lake Michigan.

Just a few miles down the road we'll stop in the village of Glen Arbor. Here we'll find charming shopping centered around local, artisan-made goods, art, and outdoor-themed retailers, not to mention divine chocolate-covered cherries in the **Cherry Republic**, the world's largest exclusive retailer of cherry products.

This afternoon we will travel along a portion of the scenic **M-22**, a 116-mile stretch of road that winds through the scenic countryside of Manistee, Benzie and Leelanau counties, on our way to the village of Leland where we'll set aside time to explore historic **Fishtown**, a living reminder of Northern Michigan's maritime history featuring rustic shanties and docks reminiscent of life and commercial fishing 150 years ago. On our return to Traverse City, we'll enjoy a **West Grand Traverse Bay Cruise** aboard the newly renovated, 65' vessel The Discovery. The Discovery offers the choice of staying cozy indoors or enjoying the refreshing breezes from the bow or outdoor patio, being the only double-decker tour boat on West Grand Traverse Bay. What a wonderful way to enjoy the sparkling emerald waters of the West Grand Traverse Bay! **(B,L)**

Wed., Oct. 7 – TRAVERSE CITY (Old Mission)

Another leisurely day on tour begins with a drive to the Old Mission Peninsula, a 22-mile-long stretch of land that divides the East and West Grand Traverse Bays. We'll enjoy the views as we travel through rolling hillsides past cherry orchards, vineyards and wineries, as we make our way to the **Mission Point Lighthouse**. Located at the end of the M-37, this historic landmark was once used to guide mariners through West Grand Traverse Bay. Our next stop will take us to **Chateau Chantal** for a wine tasting at their beautiful winery nestled in the rolling hills of Northern Michigan's Old Mission Peninsula, that has a rich history rooted in family and farming. Following our wine tasting, it's a short drive to the **Jolly Pumpkin Restaurant & Brewery**. Located in a historic 19th-century mansion, the Jolly Pumpkin features artisan fare with an on-site brewery and large seasonal outdoor dining with breathtaking views of West Bay.

The afternoon is free to explore downtown Traverse City at your leisure. Within easy walking distance of our hotel, you'll find a vibrant, pedestrian-friendly hub known for its blend of small-town charm and big-city offerings, featuring a mix of unique boutiques, diverse restaurants, and cultural attractions on central Front Street and the Warehouse District. **(B,L)**

Thurs., Oct. 8 – TRAVERSE CITY (Boyne Valley)

This morning, we will travel to the **Boyne Mountain Resort**, tucked away in the breathtaking Boyne Valley. In the fall, Boyne Mountain offers a variety of activities including enjoying the ever-changing fall foliage, and that's exactly what we'll do. We'll begin with a **Chairlift Ride** into the fresh Northern Michigan air to the summit to enjoy the fall foliage. You'll also have an opportunity to take a walk on the wild side across the **Michigan SkyBridge**. This architectural masterpiece is the world's longest timber-towered suspension bridge that floats 118 feet above Boyne Valley. On our return to Traverse City, we'll include a stop at the popular **Friske Orchards & Farm Market**.

Tonight we will travel to the **Rove Winery**. Perched atop the highest point on the Leelanau Peninsula at the Gallagher Estate, the family operation focuses its attention on the estate-grown grapes to honor their Michigan legacy and Irish ancestry. We'll enjoy a sampling of their wines accompanied by locally sourced small plates along with a breathtaking sunset view. **(B,D)**
